

Caithness Art and Stone Festival - Existing Work

Deadline: Saturday 1st February 2025

This is a call-out for artists of all medias to display work at the *Caithness Art* and *Stone Festiva*l in August 2025. The exhibition will show work which explores the rocks and minerals in Caithness, from flagstone quarries to astronomy. Fossils and cliffs are natural formations in this landscape and man-made structures use stone too. We welcome all interpretations of this theme and are excited to see the variety of work produced.

We will accept all medias, so long as they fit into the exhibition space! This includes photography, sculpture, performance, digital and audio work.

We are looking for artworks which relate to the themes of:

- natural rock and stone formations in Caithness
- stone placed and structured by people in Caithness
- ores, minerals, gems, meteorites found in Caithness
- how stone forms in Caithness are affected by the climate crisis in any way







Guidelines

The exhibition will run from Mon 4th – Sat 16th August 2025.

We ask that existing work has not been exhibited before and has been produced between 2023 and 2024.

Each artist can exhibit up to 5 pieces of work.

Each work needs to be ready for exhibition (eg framed, upon a plinth, printed, labeled, etc) by **Sat 26**th **July** and removed by **Sun 17**th **August**.

Each artist will provide a text about themselves and the labels and prices of their art world if they are for sale.

We will be making a video record of the project which each artist will contribute to.

Work may be available for sale if the artist would like, with 10% commission taken by the project.

The fee for each exhibited piece of work is £50

This fee and the exhibition are funding-dependent. We will sign contracts with artists when the funding has been secured.
